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Omission of a Strategic Site at Brockhill West.

Brockhill West is an entirely appropriate location for residential development which was recently identified as part of Redditch Borough's 5 Year Land Supply despite being within the Green Belt.

This objection to the omission of Brockhill West as a strategic site is also the subject of separate statement relating to both the BRLP4 and Bromsgrove District Plan (BDP).

The proposed level of housing provision for Redditch overall is considered inadequate and there are also compelling objections to the full extent of the Foxlydiate urban extension proposal in the BDP in respect of both suitability and delivery in the Plan period.

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The capacity of Redditch Borough is concluded to be some 3,200 dwellings as land at Brockhill West is suitable for residential development within the Borough as evidenced by the land's inclusion for 150 dwellings within the Borough's Five Year Housing Land Supply statement in 2012 (p27 refers).

Brockhill West is a suitable cross-boundary location for housing growth at a scale of at least 200 dwellings in Redditch Borough and up to 900 dwellings in Bromsgrove District. It provides a suitable alternative overall of approximately 1,100 dwellings to the full extent of the Foxlydiate proposal in Bromsgrove District of 2,800 dwellings where delivery within the Plan period is not realistic and Green Belt impacts preclude the ability to demonstrate exceptional circumstances. There is potential for additional housing development on the western edge of the Brockhill East proposal in Bromsgrove District to include further deliverable land if it is concluded the Foxlydiate proposal west of Redditch, proposed in the

Bromsgrove District Plan (BDP), is unsound from either its unsuitability and/or its deliverability at the required scale. The Brockhill (East) Strategic Site in Bromsgrove District in the BDP is assessed by Persimmon as having a capacity of about 700 dwellings.

The objectively assessed need for Redditch is considered to be greater than 6,400 dwellings. Accordingly, the cross-boundary element in Bromsgrove District should be set at a minimum level of 3,200 plus the required increase above 6,400 dwellings to meet the objectively assessed level of need. The basis for this objection rests on the Worcestershire SHMA Monitoring Report 2011/12 dated June 2013 which suggests the range for Redditch is between 6,235 and 9,724 dwellings between 2011 and 2030. In this context, the 6,400 proposed housing requirement is at the lower end of the range and not the middle as indicated in the Plan.

It is noted that under the current Plan strategy of providing at least 6,400 homes at Redditch, there is no prospect of delivering the number of required affordable homes in the area. Consideration should therefore be given to whether a higher overall requirement would be appropriate.

There is a justification for increasing the Redditch Borough Requirement to <u>at least 3,200</u> dwellings and revisiting the minimum cross boundary requirement in Bromsgrove District to 3,200 dwellings plus the necessary increase overall to meet the correctly assessed objective housing need.

This reflects the additional capacity at Brockhill West and conforms with the NPPF objective of seeking significantly to boost the supply of housing. It is noted the reference in the Bromsgrove Plan is for a minimum level of provision in the District to meet the needs of Redditch and a consistent approach is merited.
